

## Directions to the Hamilton Wetland Restoration Project Site

From **Highway 101 South**, take Nave Drive Exit. Which is the next one after Lucas Valley Road Exit. Stay on Nave Drive to Main Gate Road. **From 101 North** take Bel Marin Keys Boulevard exit. Cross over 101 to the east side and turn right onto Nave Drive. Continue south on Nave Drive to North Hamilton Parkway. Continue for ½ mile (you will see the skateboard park on your left).

There are three main trailheads as shown below.

1. **Reservoir Hill:** From **Main Gate Road**, take a left at the fork in the road and head up the hill on North Hamilton Parkway. Trailhead is on the right. From North Hamilton Parkway, the trailhead is near the bottom of the hill, on the left. There is limited parking at the trailhead but more parking across the street at the junction of Palm Drive. *This location has great views.*
2. **Hangar Parking Lot.** There is a ramp that goes over the City's levee and connects to the trail. The ramp is just opposite the old Control Tower. *This location has quick access to the trail and is near food services.*
3. **End of Hanger Avenue.** There is a service road at the end of Hanger Avenue that connects directly to the trail. Parking is at the park next to the road's end. *This location has excellent parking and access to the southern seasonal wetlands.*

Note: There are no public restrooms onsite and all trash must be packed out. The area is a wildlife area so please enjoy quietly and stick to the trail.
